## Halloween Safety Tips

- S** – Swords, knives, and other costume accessories should be short, soft, and flexible. Be certain they do not appear authentic.
  - A** – Avoid trick-or-treating alone. A parent or trusted adult should always accompany young children.
  - F** – Fasten reflective tape to costumes and bags to help drivers see you. Plan costumes that are reflective and bright.
  - E** – Examine all treats for choking hazards and tampering before eating them and avoid eating treats made by strangers.

- H** – Hold a flashlight while trick-or-treating to help you see and others see you. Remember to WALK and don't run from house to house.
  - A** – Always test make-up in a small area first. Remove it before bedtime to prevent possible skin and eye irritation.
  - L** – Look both ways before crossing the street and use crosswalks wherever possible instead of crossing mid-block.
  - L** – Limit your trick-or-treating to familiar streets and neighborhoods. Parents make it clear if certain areas or homes are off limits.
  - O** – Only walk on sidewalks whenever possible, or on the far edge of the road facing traffic to stay safe.
  - W** – Wear well-fitting masks, costumes, and shoes to avoid blocked vision, trips, and falls.
  - E** – Enclose your phone number and address in your child's bag in case you become separated.
  - E** – Enter homes only if you are with a trusted adult, only visit well-lit houses, and never accept rides from strangers.
  - N** – Never walk near lit candles or luminaries. Be sure to wear flame-resistant costumes.
