ORDINANCE NO. 2023-400

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOYALSOCK, LYCOMING COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 205 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC OF THE
CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOYALSOCK BY AMENDING
SECTION 205-21 PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES BY ADDING THE EAST
SIDE OF WARREN AVENUE AND A PORTION OF PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE'S
EAST SIDE**

WHEREAS, the Township of Loyalsock (the "Township") has the authority under the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. § 65101) and the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (75 Pa. C.S. § 101 et seq.) to regulate parking on the roads within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that it is in the best interests of the safety and welfare of the Township citizens that parking be prohibited on the east side of Warren Avenue (T-474) its entire length from the corner of Sheridan Street (T-616) to the corner of Four Mile Drive (S.R. 2018); and to prohibit parking at all times on the east side of Pennsylvania Avenue (T-472) from the corner of Washington Boulevard (S.R. 2106) to the corner of Sheridan Street (T-616).

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

PART 1

Chapter 205, Vehicles and Traffic shall be amended as follows:

The following shall be added to Section 205-21. Parking Prohibited at all times; violations and penalties.:

A.

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
Warren Avenue (T-474)	East	From Sheridan Street (T-616) to Four Mile Drive (S.R. 2018)

B.

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
Pennsylvania Avenue (T-472)	East	From Washington Boulevard (S.R. 2106) to Sheridan Street (T-616)

PART 2


All other provisions of Chapter 205 Vehicles and Traffic are hereby reaffirmed.
